ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Thanks to those who have already removed their holiday lighting. The committee kindly requests that owners remove their holiday lighting in a timely manner, previously requested as no later than Feb. 28.

As a reminder, per CC&R Article 6.01, changes to exterior structures (including, but not limited to, windows, painting, garage door replacements, fence replacements) require approval by the Architectural Committee or the Board. While most owners comply with this requirement, we still encounter situations in which projects are performed without approval. Please help avoid potential conflict by checking first before embarking on an exterior project. Please also note that there are multiple documents posted on our website covering the rules for painting exterior structures and garage doors. Please contact a committee member with any questions. We thank you for your cooperation.

LANDSCAPE

During the month of March the maintenance crew, besides normal clean up, completed the following projects;

- Cleaned more debris from concrete swale between Toyon and Parkwood Ct.
- Crew is now patrolling all sidewalks and landscape along streets for trash rather than sections per week.
- Lowered sprinkler head on Parkwood Dr. as requested near sidewalk.
- Spot sprayed for weeds.
- Removed low Oak Tree branches from sidewalk along Parkwood Dr.
- Leafwood-Douglas trimmed volunteer runners and shrubs in common areas.
- Completed 1900 Parkwood Ct. Enhancement in common area.
