ARCHITECTURAL COMMITTEE

Garage Door Reminder - Please note that garage door replacements require architectural approval for both type and color, per the CC&Rs.

Thanks for the lovely holiday lighting. Please plan to remove your holiday lighting no later than February 16. Thanks for your cooperation!

LANDSCAPE

In addition to standard activities, the following work was or will be performed in common / easement areas during Dec/Jan:

- All irrigation timers and water flows off for winter
- Repaired leaking shutoff valve at Cheryl Court
- Cleared all leaf debris from end of streets and visitor parking areas
- Trimmed all volunteer growth in common/easement areas on De Anza Blvd
- Continued trash removal each visit.

The landscape committee did a great job during 2013 addressing the issues that arose and still staying within budget! This included accomplishing the large tree trimming Fire Break Project, getting all our common areas addressed in one year, and addressing the once-in-ten-year Oak Moth infestation. Please come to the Annual Meeting to hear a comprehensive summary of the 2013 Landscaping program.

Finally, please do not trim/cut any trees in common areas. Branches from common area trees that overhang a homeowner's yard are not trimmed by the HOA unless they present a fire hazard. If you want to trim for view (at your cost), or have a concern, call PML or talk to a Board member. We have a process to follow. The first step is for you to identify the work you would like done. The HOA has a list of approved arborists/firms that can perform work on HOA trees. You would submit a quotation from one of these approved firms to the HOA for board approval before any work is performed. Thanks for your cooperation.

TRASH / RECYCLING – PLEASE FOLLOW CC&Rs & CITY LAWS

Recology has issued instructions for <u>Christmas Tree recycling</u>. Through January 31, Recology will pick up holiday trees on our regular collection day. Remove all decorations and tree stands (flocked trees are OK) before placing next to your Compost Cart for collection. Trees longer than 8 feet in length must be cut into shorter lengths before being placed next to the Compost Cart. After January 31, trees need to be cut into pieces and placed inside the Compost Cart (with all pieces fitting inside the cart).

Please remember that, per CC&Rs Section 5.08 (and per SM City Code!), your trash and recycling bins need to be kept out of sight, except on pickup day or the day prior. They may not be stored anywhere in sight from a street, neighboring lot, or common area. Let's all help keep the neighborhood looking nice.
